2 Thessalonians 1:11-12

- Doing good is the result of <u>knowing</u> God, who is good. *Psalm 34:8; Luke 4:18-19; Acts 10:38; Romans 2:4 (NKJV) Romans 8:28; James 1:17-18*
- 2. God IS good. It's not just what he $\underline{\text{does}}$; it's who he $\underline{\text{is}}$ pure goodness!
- 3. The Problem: Human goodness is <u>tainted</u>. *Romans 3:10; Romans 3:23; Titus 3:4-8; 2 Thessalonians 1:11-12*
- <u>Pure</u> goodness comes from God and when lived out will <u>show</u> his goodness to the world around us. *Romans 12:9-21*

Connect:

Have each person share a high and low from this past week.

Consider:

Doing good is the result of knowing God, who is good.

Choose one or two questions for your group to discuss as time allows.

- Let's discuss 2 Thessalonians 1:11-12 in depth.
 - What does it mean to "live a life worthy of his call"?
 - How do people know when their faith has prompted them?
 - What keeps people from moving on those prompts?
 - What is at stake if we don't move on prompts?
 - What happens if we do move on the prompts?

Commit:

Spend 1-2 minutes in silence with these questions then share your thoughts.

Read Romans 12:9-21 with the question "What can I do to help?" in mind. Ask God for a personal prompt.

Share your prompt with the group.

Care:

Thank God for the highs mentioned earlier and remember the lows in prayer. Pray 2 Thessalonians 1:11-12 over your group and our church.
