- ▶ Read Ephesians 2:19-20. As believers, how are we like stones built together to make a house? What could make that house weak?

*Spend 1-2 minutes in silence with these questions then share your thoughts.*

Read 1 Peter 2:9. Which of the identities listed intrigues you and why? What does that identity give you so “you can show others the goodness of God”?

Read Hebrews 13:15-17. What is one specific way you are being prompted to show your allegiance to God?
