Connect:

Have each person share a high and low from this past week.

Consider:

Choose one or two questions for your group to discuss as time allows.

- ▶ Read Jeremiah 31:31-34. What are some significant parts of the new normal that Jesus introduced with the new covenant?

- ▶ As you read Mark 14: 22-26, think about the three concepts mentioned: Celebration, Reconciliation, and Invitation. Which one has deeper meaning to you now and why?

- ▶ Read Luke 22:14-16. What are some possible reasons as to why Jesus was eager to eat the meal with them?

Commit:

Spend 1-2 minutes in silence with these questions then share your thoughts.

What can you do to celebrate God's provision in your life?
