Small Group Outline & Discussion Questions

Connect:

Have each person share a high and low from this past week.

Consider:

Jesus came to free the oppressed.

Choose one or two questions for your group to discuss as time allows.

- ▶ Read Luke 13:10-11. What are some of the weights that could make a person feel crippled and downcast?
- ▶ Read Luke 13:12. Share a time when you felt seen by someone else or by God directly.
- ▶ Read Luke 13:13. When God touches someone what happens? Where in our lives do we need a touch from God? How could we give that touch to others?
- ▶ Read Luke 13:14-17. What does it mean to be indignant? How might we be missing the point in our culture today?

Commit:

Spend 1-2 minutes in silence with these questions then share your thoughts.

Read Luke 4:18-19. Which of the offerings to set the oppressed free do you need to receive today?

- Good news for the poor
- Freedom for prisoners
- Recovery of sight for the blind

Is there someone you feel compelled to share one of these offers with?
