Parable - "A truth thrown alongside a story."

Luke 15:1-10

Misplaced people are worth being sought after.

The Holy Spirit moves at the Father's will, and the Father's will is that no one be <u>misplaced</u>.

1. <u>Value</u> the one.

"Only a life lived for others is a life worthwhile." Albert Einstein *1 Peter 3:18*

2. Pray for the one.

Once you begin to value someone, the Holy Spirit makes it irresistible to pray for them.

John 17:20 (NIV)

- 3. Be <u>alert</u> for the one.

 - Be a true friend who encourages.
