Small Group Outline & Discussion Questions

Connect:

Have each person share a high and low from this past week.

Consider:

With the Holy Spirit living in us and God being on our side, we can be strong in the storms that come our way.

Choose one or two questions for your group to discuss as time allows.

- During difficult times, is it easier to be thankful and pray or to complain? What is your first response to difficult times?
- In the middle of a storm, we can rely on our faith in God by believing and speaking scripture. Share some verses that help you stay strong in the storm.
- God's word is alive and powerful! Read 2 Corinthians 4:5-9 (NLT). Which part of these verses speaks to you the most today?
- Pastor Sam spoke about patience, joy, and wisdom. Read James 1:2-4. How can all 3 work together when troubles come our way?

Commit:

Spend 1-2 minutes in silence with these questions then share your thoughts.

Meditate on the lyrics to the "Promises" song:

I put my faith in Jesus My anchor to the ground My hope and firm foundation He'll never let me down

Take a moment to speak these truths into your situation and into other's situations that come to mind.

Care:

Pray for the people in your Group who are going through a storm right now, and pray for the storms in our nation. Ask God to give us wisdom in every situation as we put our faith and trust in Him.
