## Small Group Outline & Discussion Questions

### Connect:

Have each person share a high and low from this past week.

### Consider:

Prayer with participation leads to God’s power.

*Choose one or two questions for your group to discuss as time allows.*

- ▶ Read Nehemiah 1:5. Nehemiah started his prayer with praise and reminded God of who He is, “the great and awesome God.” Share your favorite praises to God?
- ▶ When Nehemiah’s brother shared the news, Nehemiah did not respond with indifference, but was moved with compassion. Name some of Nehemiah’s actions and share why they are important.
- ▶ Pastor Matt said the story of Nehemiah points to the heart of Jesus and referenced Matthew 9:35-38. Is your prayer, “Lord send more workers” or “Lord send me”?

### Commit:

*Spend 1-2 minutes in silence with these questions then share your thoughts.*

What situations (brokenness) in your life, or in our world today, are moving you to weep and fall to your knees? What can you do this week to be a difference maker?

### Care:

Thank God for the high’s mentioned before. Pray and ask God to soften our hearts everyday to be more like Him, so that we can move with compassion and love for others.
