Small Group Outline & Discussion Questions

Celebrate and Care:

Have each person share a high and low from this past week.

Big Idea:

Words are powerful. They can bring life or death, encouragement or discouragement. Words are like seeds; we need to weigh them before we say them and choose to plant words that will produce life.

Open Up:

What are some words of life that have been planted in you?

Discuss:

Choose one or two questions for your group to discuss as time allows.

- Read Proverbs 18:21. What are some practical tips we can use to weigh our words before we say them?
- ► How can we keep negative words spoken over us from taking root?
- Make a list of word seeds that could be planted in others, for example, "I see _____ in you" or "You're really good at _____"
- Who do you want to intentionally plant word seeds of life into?

Engage:

Spend 1–2 minutes in silence with these questions then share your thoughts.

Have you have planted word seeds you don't want to grow? If so, ask God for the courage to acknowledge your words and ask for forgiveness back.

Who is one person you can intentionally plant a word seed of life into this week?

Close together in prayer.

Ask your heavenly Father for a word he is speaking over you.
