## Small Group Outline & Discussion Questions

### Celebrate and Care:

Have each person share a high and low from this past week.

### Review:

God can produce significance from what seems insignificant.

### Open Up:

How do you feel about setting up Christmas decorations – love it or leave it?

### Discuss:

*Choose one or two questions for your group to discuss as time allows.*

- ▶ Think of a life-changing moment for you, now consider the “insignificant” parts that came together to make that moment happen. Who was faithful and became a part of your story?
- ▶ Read Luke 13:18-19. How does the kingdom of God differ from worldly kingdoms?
- ▶ In the story of the feeding of the five thousand, God already knew what he was going to do. How could that mindset change how we trust him when we’re in the middle of a situation?
- ▶ How can God use what seems like inopportune or inconvenient timing for our good?

### Engage:

*Spend 1-2 minutes in silence with these questions then share your thoughts.*

What sparked in your heart when you heard, “God has already placed in you what he wants to do through you.”

Read Zechariah 4:10. What is a “small beginning” that God may be asking you to “not despise?”

What is an obstacle you are facing that God wants you to view as an opportunity?

### Pray:

*Pray that God will show us where he is more than enough in our “not enough” situations”.*
