Discuss:

Choose one or two questions for your group to discuss as time allows.

- How do you discern if a dream is from God?

- Read Romans 12:1-2 (MSG). How can we reorient our response when a door closes to see that what may seem like a disappointment could be a reappointment?

Engage:

Spend 1-2 minutes in silence with these questions then share your thoughts.

Where in your life might God want you to see that you have "overestimated what you can accomplish in a short period of time but underestimated what God can accomplish in a lifetime"?

Is God asking you for a response to "step out of your comfort and step into your calling"?

What is a promise to hold on to for this season, or will you commit to finding one?

Ask God for clear resolution for this year.
